WHO CAN PARTICIPATE? Early care educators across the state of Nevada working with children 0-5 years. This program is open to any new hire within their first 120 days (4 months) of employment at a licensed childcare facility or in-home childcare.

HOW TO ENROLL? A referral must be made from a licensed center director/administrator.

WHEN ARE THE SESSIONS? The Academy sessions will be offered August, October, January, March, and May.

WHAT IS THE COST? The Spiral Up Academy Level 1 is currently funded and being offered at no cost.

DIRECTOR'S ROLE: Directors will be given resources and support to continue mentoring new staff after the conclusion of the Academy.
